The Regular City/School Election will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2019. All eligible electors of Guthrie County are eligible to vote in the City/School Election as long as they are:

- A citizen of the United States
- A resident of Iowa and of Guthrie County
- At least 18 years of age

An eligible elector must NOT:

- Be a convicted felon (unless voting rights have been restored by the President or Governor)
- Be currently judged incompetent to vote by a court

POLLING HOURS ARE: 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. at all polling places on Tuesday, November 5, 2019.

Thursday, September 19	Regular City/School Candidate Filing Deadline Last day to file nomination papers with Auditor or Designated City Clerk for City election and school secretaries for School Election Auditor, Designated City Clerks and School Secretaries open until 5 p.m.
Tuesday, September 24	Regular City/School Candidate Withdraw/Objection Deadline Last day for candidates to withdraw & objection to candidates. File with Auditor for City and school secretaries for school. Both Auditor & School Secretary open until 5 p.m.
Monday, October 7	Regular City/School Absentee Voting begins First day absentee ballots can be mailed to voters

Monday, October 21	<p>Regular City/School Election Worry-Free Postmark Deadline Mailed voter registration forms which are postmarked on or before today are considered on time to be pre-registered</p>
Friday, October 25	<p>Regular City/School Election Voter Pre-Registration & Absentee Requests Deadline Deadline to pre-register to vote. After today voters can register using Election Day Registration procedures which require proof of ID & residency. Also, deadline to request absentee ballot to be mailed.</p> <p>Auditor open until 5 p.m.</p>
Monday, November 4	<p>Regular City/School Absentee In-Person Deadline Last day to vote Absentee in-person at Auditor's Office</p> <p>Auditor open until 5 p.m.</p>
Tuesday, November 5	<p>Regular City/School Election Must vote at your assigned polling location 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.</p>
Monday, November 11	<p>Veteran's Day – County offices closed</p>
Tuesday, November 12	<p>Regular/City School 1st Canvass Board of Supervisor's certify votes and official results</p>
Friday, November 15	<p>Recount Request Deadline Requests must be written and filed with the Auditor by 5 p.m.</p> <p>Auditor open until 5 p.m.</p>
Tuesday, November 19	<p>Regular City/School 2nd Canvass Board of Supervisor's certify votes and official results after non-control results are reported to Guthrie County</p>
